Soil samples analysis confirms fears of farmers in Delta region

Seven samples — four soil, two surface water and one groundwater — were collected from Thanjavur, Thiruvarur and Nagapattinam districts for analysis

THE voice of dissent against the hydrocarbon project in Neduvasal in Pudukottai district and the recent oil leak from the Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) pipeline in Kathiraman-galam village in Thanjavur district has gained momentum with the scientific analysis of soil, groundwater and surface water samples having confirmed that hydrocarbons stay in the environment for several years and will kill the productivity of Tamil Nadu's rice bowl — the Cauvery

delta. Seven samples — four soil, two surface water and one groundwater — were collected from Thanjavur, Thiruvarur and Nagapattinam districts and were given for analysis at authorised CVR Labs in Saidapet in Chennai, which confirmed presence of total petroleum hydrocarbon (TPH), which activists claim is due to oil extraction and refining. Dismissing the ONGC's claim that oil leaks and spills were dealt with appropriately, two soil samples that were collected from a farm in Thirupunjai in Thiru-

varur district, which was contaminated during an oil spill more than a decade ago, showed presence of 1760 mg/kg and 2983 mg/kg of TPH respectively. Given that uncontaminated soils should have no trace of TPH, the levels found in the Thirupunjai field are exceedingly high and highlight the failure of the ONGC to deploy remedial measures to restore the paddy lands, said Nityanand Jayaraman of Chennai Solidarity Group, addressing a press conference on Wednesday. In an emotional outburst, delta farmers, Kasturi and Annadurai, have alleged that an entire gen-

eration was getting affected due to hydrocarbon operations by the ONGC and the CPCL. "Our children are literally drinking poison and several have been afflicted with life-threatening ailments over the years. We have spared our land for laying pipelines trusting them and now we are fighting for our lives. Police are treating us like naxals, if we protest. The government and the district administration are taking sides with the polluter," they alleged. Chandra Mohan of Arapoor Iyakkam said that even 38 days after June 30 spill in Kathiraman-

galam village, the ONGC hasn't taken remediation measures and as a result pollutants are contaminating public water resources and Velloor irrigation canal. Two sets of water and soil samples taken from Sriram Ramamoorthy's certified organic farm, which is the epicenter of the June 30 spill, contained TPH ranging from 33.9 mg/L in water to 1.118 mg/kg in soil. Piyush Manush of SpeakOut Salem said that the activists groups would mobilise farmers and file private complaint in the local district magistrate court shortly.

Villupuram district gets ₹1,000 cr desalination project

CHIEF Minister Edappadi K Palaniswami on Wednesday announced a ₹1,000-crore project to convert seawater into drinking water in the district. Participating in the birth centenary celebrations of AIADMK founder and late Chief Minister M G Ramachandran at Kandamanadi near Janagipuram highway, he said the project would help curb water scarcity in the region. As per the project, 100 million litres of fresh water would be produced from salt water taken from coastal areas of the district. He also allocated an additional ₹198 crore to extend underground sewerage schemes at the newly expanded town limits of Kakuppam, Salamedu, Panampattu, Vazhuhareddy and Earumantthangal.

Hailing the late Chief Minister, Palaniswami said MGR was the only "unique" leader who is still living in people's hearts. He also expressed his gratitude to late Chief Minister J Jayalalitha for giving him a chance to serve the people as CM. Palaniswami also said the State's higher secondary passout rate has risen from 21 per cent to 44.3 per cent, after a decade-long effort of Jayalalitha.

He listed out the welfare measures that his government had announced for Villupuram district, including approval of 31,146 free houses worth ₹867 lakh under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana and setting up of government arts and science college for women for ₹15 crore and a government law college at a cost of ₹50 crore. Narrating a short moral story, Palaniswami also warned his partymen who had formed a separate faction and were making cunning political moves to gain powers.

On the other hand, he also invited the rebel faction to reunite with the party founded by the people's leader (Makkal Thilagam) MGR and to work for public welfare. State ministers and MLAs, including Minister for Law, Courts and Prison C Ve Shanmugam, School Education Minister K A Sengottaiyan, Assembly Speaker Dhanapal, Ulundurpet MLA R Kumaraguru and Villupuram Collector Dr L Subramanian also participated in the function. Welfare measures and prizes to the winners of competitions held in connection with the MGR birth centenary celebrations were given away during the function.

6-month jail for Sun TV staff in defamation case

THE Judicial Magistrate Court here on Wednesday awarded six months imprisonment to Sun TV editor V Raja and a reporter in a criminal defamation complaint lodged by a former reporter of Tamil biweekly magazine 'Kumudham Reporter'.

Judge Lavanya awarded six months imprisonment and imposed a penalty of ₹10,000 on Sun TV editor V Raja and its Vellore reporter Rajakumar for telecasting a defamatory news report on M P Gajaraj (53), a former reporter of 'Kumudham Reporter'. On December 21, 2012, Sun News aired the report on fake reporters in the Vellore district.

Gajaraj, then Vellore district reporter of 'Kumudham Reporter', was termed as one in the district by Rajakumar. It reported that Gajaraj threatened politicians, real estate businessman and sand mafias and demanded bribe to not report about their illegal activities.

Within the next few days, 'Kumudham Reporter' management shunted out Gajaraj. He then lodged a criminal defamation case against the magazine, the woman who gave the interview and also Sun News editor Raja.

A non-bailable arrest warrant was issued against the two offenders. When Raja and Rajakumar surrendered before Judicial Magistrate Court on Thursday, Judge Lavanya sentenced them to six months in jail, besides a ₹10,000 fine on each of them. Rajalakshmi's sentence would be announced once she appeared before the court, said advocates.

Mobile phones seized from highly guarded Puzhal prison

NINE mobile phones were seized during a day's raid in the highly guarded Puzhal prison on Monday.

Prison officials conducted the operations from morning to evening in all blocks of the prison. "During the raid, we seized mobile phones from toilets, rain water harvesting points and even shoes," said a prison source.

"Someone had torn the back of a slipper, inserted a phone there and pasted it again. Mostly, the inmates hide phones in all awkward places or unexceptional places that are being used daily."

The seized phones were all basic models. These kind of basic mobiles can be easily hidden by inmates. Prison officials said the seized phones belonged to M Suresh (30), M Madhi (27), J Ramesh (22), R Rajeshkumar (20), M Yogi Krishnan (45), S Arunagiri (54) and M Ramesh (27).

Apart from cell phones, two batteries and three chargers were also recovered.

"When an offender comes to prison for the first time, he gains a little knowledge about the prison place," the source said.

"If the inmate comes twice or thrice, he will become aware of the officials' movements. They know when prison officials go for parade or go to the court and then start making calls or get into fights with other inmates. Most incidents occurred on Saturdays and Sundays when officials went for other work."

The mobile phones were seized from Block 1,2,3,4 and High Security block 1. Jammer work is in progress in the prison premises for the last one year and two months ago the jammer machine was installed, the source explained. "The work is going on," said another source. "The jammer was initially installed in the High Security block, from where it would be able to block signals for 300 metres in 360 degrees."

"Last year there were 72 mobile phone cases registered and this year so far 64 cases have been registered," an officer who is in charge of Puzhal prison told Express.

HC grants bail to Jayaraman, seven others

THE Madurai Bench of Madras High Court on Wednesday granted conditional bail to retired professor T Jayaraman and seven others who spearheaded the protest against ONGC at Kathiraman-galam village in Thanjavur district.

Residents of Kathiraman-galam village staged a protest on June 30 against ONGC following a leakage in the pipe transporting crude oil and natural gas from a well in the village.

The prosecution case was that Jayaraman and others attacked ONGC officials and damaged public property. An FIR was registered and petitioners were arrested. Jayaraman, D Murugan, S Santhosh and others approached the court for bail. Earlier, after hearing arguments, orders were reserved in the case.
