EVEN though 2019 general elections are still more than one-and-a-half year away, the state seems to have begun witnessing "realignment" of political forces.

Indicating at their likely "alliance" in the 2019 general polls against TRS, Congress and TDP, which had joined hands against the ruling party in the Palair by-poll earlier, despite their ideological differences, have again decided to move hand in hand to fight against the state government. This time, the two parties, have chosen the Singareni Collieries Company Limited (SCCL) recognised trade union polls, scheduled to be held on October 5, as an opportunity to together take on the ruling establishment.

With the last date of filing of nominations for the polls, which is September 16, just three days away, Congress and TDP leaders shared the dais at Somajiguda Press Club here on Wednesday and jointly extended their support to the All India Trade Union

Later, Uttam Reddy and Revanth Reddy called upon the 54,000 Singareni employees to vote for the AITUC in the polls to defeat the ruling TRS backed trade union, Telangana Boggu Gani Karmika Sangham (TG-BKS) (Telangana Coalmine Workers' Union).

"We have decided to extend our support to the AITUC in order to defeat the TBKS, backed by the ruling TRS. We urge the Singareni workers to vote for the AITUC to teach a befitting lesson to Chief Minister K Chandrasekhar Rao, who has cheated them by not implementing any

promise made to them earlier," Uttam said.

"Neither revival of dependent jobs scheme was implemented, nor the promise of setting up of a super-specialty hospital for Singareni workers was fulfilled. The ruling TRS has backtracked from its promise of shutting down all open cast mines," Revanth Reddy said. Even as both Uttam and Revanth were urging all the Singareni workers to vote for the AITUC in the election, CPI state secretary Chada Venkat Reddy thanked the Congress and TDP for supporting the AITUC.

In fact, as SCCL employees and their families play a major role in deciding electoral fortunes of any political party in more than 20 Assembly segments and 5 Lok Sabha constituencies spreading across six districts, the SCCL employees' election is considered by many as a gateway to mould the opinion of voters towards the 2019 general polls. That is why Congress, TDP and Left have decided to take the Singareni election as an occasion to defeat the TRS backed trade union.

HC issues notices to govts on PIL

A division bench of the High Court has issued notices to the central and the state governments of AP and Telangana to respond to a PIL, which sought bifurcation of the Telugu Akademi situated at Himayatnagar in the city.

The bench of acting chief justice Ramesh Ranganathan and justice J Uma Devi was, on Tuesday, dealing with PIL filed by MV Subba Rao, president of the Guntur district unit of All India Students Federation, seeking bifurcation of the employees and funds, which existed as on June 2, 2014, of Telugu Akademi for both the successor states.

The petitioner's counsel pointed out that after the erstwhile state's bifurcation, the Akademi, which is in Telangana state, extended the facilities to AP for only one year. The facilities and services included printing and distribution of textbooks of Intermediate, degree, D.Ed and B.Ed and competitive examinations. About 30 lakh textbooks are printed and distributed to Intermediate students in both the states and another 10 lakh to students appearing for other courses. At present, the students of AP are subjected to a lot of hardships as they are suffering for want of essential textbooks, he said.

Further, the counsel brought to the notice of the court that Telugu Akademi was listed in the X Schedule of AP Reorganisation Act 2014 and as per provisions of the Act the institutions listed in the Schedule should be bifurcated within two years from the appointed day (June 2, 2014), but till date the Centre and both the state governments have failed to take steps for its bifurcation.

The bench issued notices to the respondent governments to respond by filing counter affidavits and posted the matter to October 3 for further hearing.

Heavy rainfall warning till Saturday; Rains cut off Mukra village in A'bad dist

Hyderabad/Adilabad: India Meteorological Department (IMD) has forecasted that thunderstorm is likely to occur on Thursday and heavy rainfall on Friday and Saturday at isolated places in all districts of TS. On Wednesday, light showers were witnessed in various parts of the city. IMD also said that southwest monsoon was normal over state in the last 24 hours. In Adilabad, overflowing rivulets cut off Mukra K village from the rest of district on Wednesday after water rose in rivers and dams due to heavy rainfall over 24 hours. The highest rainfall was recorded in Echoda mandal (12 cm) and Bazarathnoor received 7 cm. The least was recorded at Uttoor and Neeradiguda.

TS witnesses peak demand of 9,510 MW power on Wednesday

Hyderabad: Telangana state witnessed a peak demand of 9,510 MW power on Wednesday. It was a record and such a demand for power was not witnessed for combined AP too in the past. The highest peak demand is witnessed due to the lack of surface water and availability of ground water for the agriculture purpose. Even after the highest peak demand for power, there is no shortage for power and no power cuts. The total power consumption in the state was around 195 million units on Wednesday and the power supply is in accordance with the demand.

Raja Sadaram likely to be named CIC

THE state government is all set to appoint the chief information commissioner (CIC) and state information commissioners. Former secretary of state legislature Raja Sadaram is likely to be named the chief information commissioner. The state information commission became defunct in April and a PIL was filed in the High Court for its reconstitution. The next date of hearing by the court is September 19.

The government constituted a committee of chief minister K Chandrasekhar Rao, opposition leader K Jana Reddy and deputy chief minister Mohamood Mohammed Ali for recommending the candidates for appointment as commissioners. The committee is likely to sit this week and finalise the names of the commissioners.

According to sources, the chief minister cleared the names for the CIC and two SICs. State legislature former secretary Raja Sadaram is likely to be made the chief information commissioner. Two journalists - Buddha Murali, working with a vernacular newspaper, and Narayana Reddy working with a vernacular TV news channel - are likely to be appointed as state information commissioners.

Though, the government can appoint ten commissioners in all, the chief minister is of the view that six commissioners will do following the division of the combined AP. After finalising the names, the list will be sent to the governor for his consent. The government will inform the court of the appointments on September 19.

Till April the those appointed in the combined AP remained in office. It is the first time that the new state government is ap-

pointing information commissioners under the Right To Information Act, 2005.

3,600 new cases have accumulated while commission was defunct

As many as 3,600 new cases have accumulated in the same period of Commission being defunct. Close to 18,000 cases on the whole are pending before the non-existent commission. The last serving IC, P Vijaya Babu vacated his post on May 15 this year after which the appellate body stood neglected until a Public Interest Litigation (PIL) was filed in July.

The Andhra Pradesh and Telangana High court in August had given both States six weeks to set up the commission as mandated by the RTI act 2005.

Following which Andhra Pradesh rented a new office at Mangalagiri in Amaravati and shifted base there.

"The bifurcation of the cases post the formation of the State can be done without much difficulty. The cases from before the formation for the state can be bifurcated based on the district they were filed from, this will help us identify which of the two Telugu state the case is from," said an official who did not wish to be named. The cases post the formation of Telangana are easy to bifurcate as they are labelled accordingly, he added.

But the bifurcation of the cases can only be initiated after the appointment of CICs for both states. "So far the state government has received over 200 applications for the post of CIC and ICs ad the posts come with good perks, but the positions may end up being political appointees like last time," said the official.

4 students of gov't blind school test positive for swine flu in M'nagar

FOUR school students from Government Blind school in Mahbubnagar, have tested positive for swine flu. The students are Divya, Ravali, Shruti and Krishnaih. All of them were shifted to Mahbubnagar district hospital. Two other students too displayed symptoms of swine flu.

Hospital authorities took their blood samples and conducted tests and found that four of the six admitted students were tested positive. District medical

and health officer Dr Ram Kishan told Express that the students were found to be suffering from swine flu after undergoing tests for typhoid, dengue, malaria and swine flu.

The students have been shifted to a special ward and are being provided the required treatment following directions from district collector Ronald Rose.

Of the swine flu victims, Divya and Shruti left to their respective natives Nalgonda and Danwada mandal in the district. Whereas, Ravali and Krishnaih are kept in a special room in the and are being treated.
